BUCKET LIST ADVENTURES FOR 2024

Let's think about an adventure, or two for 2024! Fishing Lough Corrib in Ireland. This is a large lough and obviously local knowledge is an advantage. I have some information for those who have this on their "bucket list" of places to fish. Staying at Camillaun Lodge in Oughterard, which operates as a B & B with four rooms, on the west side of the Lough the costs are: Twin/double bedded room Eu60 pp per night Single occupancy Eu90 in May – other times Eu80 Boat hire (with engine) Eu75 per day – for two anglers. Packed lunch Eu8 Guide, if hired, Eu 150 per day. As this is a **B** & **B** there are restaurants some 250 metres away in the village i.e., an eight minute walk. These premises are owned and operated by a very experienced fisherman, who tells me May and July are good months to fish! Licence required for salmon and sea-trout BUT not for trout fishing! It is also an attractive area for partners to explore.

If you have any interest in this please let me know, by email (later in text). The journey from Dublin Port is very easy, with a motorway all the way to Galway.





<u>Scourie – Sutherland</u> which I have mentioned before.

Using the excellent Scourie Hotel, the cost for single rooms on a dinner, bed and breakfast rate is £210 per night. Doubles and twins are £310 per night based on two people sharing. If staying for three nights, these prices include fishing permits to access some forty six beats. Otherwise, the permit costs £25 per rod per day.
